<u>Tumut 'Booroolong Frog' Expo Day & Senior Camp Monday December</u> <u>8th-9th</u>

Next Monday all students will be travelling to Tumut on Mick's bus to run workshops on the Booroolong Frog to the 4 Tumut schools with Tumut H.S students. The morning bus run will be half an hour earlier than normal to get us to Tumut by 9.00am. Lunch will be provided but students need water bottles and a snack for recess please. The bus will return to school at the normal time in the afternoon, dropping off the Yr 2-6 students who will stay at school to camp over with Tumut HS students on Monday night and take the infants home on the normal bus run.
